
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# BOORLEY PARK NEWSLETTER 3

This week in our assemblies, we explored our new school value: Inspiring Minds.


We thought about the meaning of curiosity and why being curious can lead to exploring wonderful ideas. The children considered what skills can help us be more curious and made some great suggestions about asking questions about the world around us and listening to each other. We discussed it being really important to share our views and understand that other people may think differently to us. The children recognised the importance of explaining their ideas.

## NURTURING FUTURES

At Boorley, we strive to be as inclusive as possible. To support us in continuing to learn about inclusion and diversity, the staff have recently had training further developing how we support children with autism.

To ensure a consistent and inclusive approach, all classes use visual timetables and images around the classroom to support with routines and instructions as well as within learning tasks.

Another strategy we have introduced following feedback from the children has been to build in regulation time at key points in the day such as the end of playtime and lunchtime. During this time children are supported with strategies to help them transition successfully from the outdoors and into the classroom.

We cannot believe it is nearly the end of September already! Throughout the month of October, we are encouraging the Boorley community to take part in Walktober. This involves walking, cycling or scooting to and from school.

We are aware that pupils in school have been accessing inappropriate content whilst using You Tube. In school the children openly talk about what they have seen online and share this information with their peers.

To help protect your child from viewing age inappropriate content you are able to create an account for under 13s with a Google account managed by Family Link. This will give you access to content settings and parental controls to help manage what channels they can subscribe to and how long they spend on the app. You can also enable a restricted mode. ### What Parents & Educators Need to Know about

### & SUBSCRIPTION FEE

Users need to pay F.E.B3 per month to play Final Fontany XIV, but there is a free trial. If someone stops paying, they II lose access to their character (othough they II be able to pick up the payments again and resume when they left off). 


